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

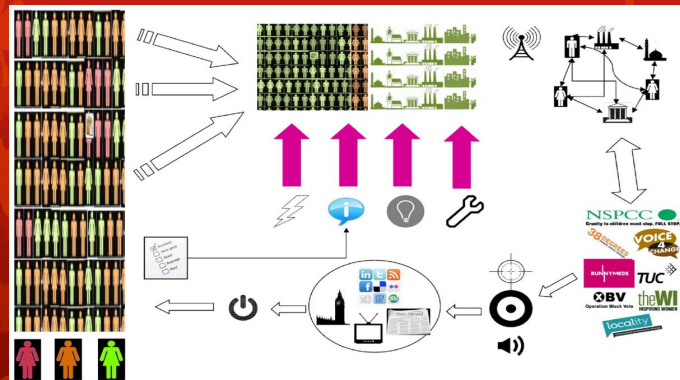
Video ART Postcards

Financial Inclusion



- The study finds significant indicative data that Black and minority ethnic (BME) groups' experience of disadvantage is impacting their access to financial institutions and services.
- Disadvantages among BME groups indicate greater risk of financial exclusion, which in turn impacts not only access to banking or credit, but also a person's economic well-being, autonomy and participation in democratic society.
