L35. Embroidery

## 1. Task Assignment

Draw a pattern on an A3 (29.7 X 42 Cm ) sized silk, and then use the required embroidery techniques to design a "Decorative Embroidery".

## 2. Allocated Time

6 Hours

## 3. Instructions

A. Transfer the sketch of the design on to the silk with precision.
B. Have good understanding of the design and think of the overall balance of the product, then use the following embroidery techniques to embroider.

- Use all 10 embroidery techniques: outline stitch, satin stitch, long \& short stitch, cross stitch, slanted flat stitch, chain stitch, honey comb stitch, french knot stitch, couching stitch and lazy daisy stitch.
- Draw the sketch in the centre of the background fabric considering the fabric grain.
C. Contestants must give shading, perspective and solidness to express the theme well with the given colored threads, considering the overall balance.


## 4. Requirements

A. Use appropriate techniques for the product.
B. Overall coloring must be well balanced considering the perspective, shading and solidness.
C. Contestants must inspect the provided materials before the contest, and notify the judges for replacements if any defects are found. However, materials must not be replaced nor provided again during the contest.
D. Contestants are not permitted to use the copy machine when transferring the sketch.
E. The completed product must not be stained or marked, and contestants must submit their products after cleaning and tiding their working space.
F. Timing of the contest will begin when the sketch is transferred, until the contestant submits the completed work.
G. Contestants are expected to keep silent and are required to remain in their seats during the contest
